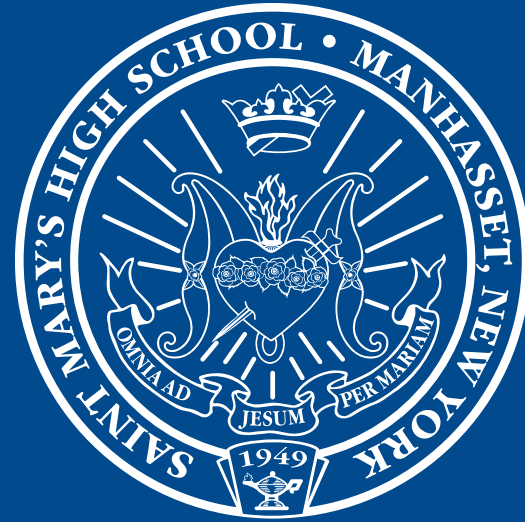

Dr. Kevin McBride

was a member of the Saint Mary's High School community for 33 years. He came to St. Mary's Boys' High School in 1977 as a biology and chemistry teacher. He taught theology and became the department chairperson while serving as director of Campus Ministry. In 1989, he became assistant principal. After serving in this capacity for seven years, he began his 14 year-long tenure as Principal.

In 1992, under Dr. McBride's leadership, Saint Mary's High School successfully returned to its original co-educational model. One of Kevin's greatest passions while principal was to create an environment of tolerance, love and understanding within the school community. He worked diligently to design

and implement the Accreditation for Growth (AFG) Project which integrates the Gospel Values into all aspects of the curriculum. This has become one of the distinguishing hallmarks of a St. Mary's education.

An undergraduate alumnus of St. John's University, he received a Master's in Bio Ed from CW Post, Long Island University and a Master's and Doctorate in Theology from the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington.

He is currently a Pastoral Associate at Saint Dominic's in Oyster Bay, where works with numerous parish ministries.

Larry Siedlick '68

was one of the founders of Sunrise Medical Laboratories in 1972 and served as its Chief Executive Officer until July 2009. Sunrise is recognized as one of the most successful laboratories in the U.S. and located just outside New York City. In 2007 Sunrise became part of Sonic Healthcare's worldwide federation of laboratories. During his leadership Sunrise received numerous nationally recognized business awards including being named in 2007 to Inc. Magazine's "5000 Fastest Growing Private Companies in America." Mr. Siedlick has over 35 years executive level experience. He is also a member the Clinical Laboratory Management Association (CLMA) and the American Association of Clinical Chemistry (AACC). He has advocated extensively for the laboratory profession at the national legislative level in the US.

Mr. Siedlick's management strategies for creating high performance corporate culture have been the subject of numerous professional publications. He is a recognized expert and has spoken at numerous laboratory and business conferences in the US, Canada and the United Kingdom on the subject of creating high performance corporate culture.

He is currently the CEO of The ARx Group which provides revenue management services to laboratories throughout the US. He serves as a member of the Saint Mary's School Board for the High School and has been an active alumni leader.
